## **CactusWorld**LIVE! *The National Show* – RULES

All entries must reach the National Show Secretary by Monday 22 August 2022.

WITHOUT EXCEPTION, NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THAT DATE.

Entry constitutes agreement with these Rules.

1. Entries will be accepted only from members of the British Cactus and Succulent Society (BCSS).
2. There is no limit to the number of entries per class, the entries being free. Entries must be sent to the National Show Secretary, Hazel Taylor, at [hazeltaylorcs@outlook.com](mailto:hazeltaylorcs@outlook.com).
3. In classes 137, 138 and 139, entries will be accepted only from Junior members of the Society.
4. The Judges are permitted to exhibit in classes other than those they are judging, at the discretion of the BCSS Shows Committee.
5. The Judges may, at their discretion, withhold any award in any class where they consider the standard of the exhibits to be too low.
6. Judging will be in accordance with the Rules and Recommendations as laid down in the BCSS Handbook of Shows 11th Edition.
7. The classification of plants shall, for the purposes of this show, be that given in the BCSS Handbook of Shows 11th Edition.
8. No pot may contain more than one plant, unless permitted specifically in the class schedule.
9. Prizes of a nominal amount are awarded to recognise the cultivation skills of the exhibitor. Subject to rule 5, prize monies in classes 1–147, except class 146, will be as follows:  
1st Prize...£7.00;                      2nd Prize...£5.00;                      3rd Prize...£3.00.  
Memorial awards, Classes 137–139 inclusive and Classes 146 and 148 also carry specific monetary awards.
10. The Society's Trophies and other Awards will be awarded as indicated in the souvenir programme. Gold Medals and National Diplomas will be awarded by a panel of Judges. A Keith Grantham Silver Medal will be awarded to the exhibitor gaining the most points in classes 1 to 60 and to the exhibitor gaining the most points in classes 61 to 130, the points allocated being as follows:  
1st...5 points;                      2nd...4 points;                      3rd...3 points;  
Highly Commended...2 points;      Commended...1 point.
11. Any objection to the judging must be submitted in writing to the National Show Secretary, accompanied by a fee of £10, before 1.30pm on 3 September 2022. The fee will be returned if your objection is upheld.
12. All entries must be staged by 9.00am on 3 September 2022. The placing of entries on the benches will be under the directions of the stewards appointed by the BCSS Shows Committee. By 9.15am on the day of the show all exhibitors must leave the show hall. During judging only persons authorised by the BCSS Shows Committee will be present.
13. Plants must be the property of the exhibitor.
14. The BCSS Shows Committee has sought advice about the staging of CITES listed plants and have been advised that exhibiting of CITES listed plants at the Show is acceptable.
15. Exhibits may not be removed from the show bench on 3 September until authorised by the Show Managers. This will not normally be before 5.00pm, but may be slightly earlier, depending on circumstances, **but the hall must be cleared by 6.00pm.**
16. The BCSS Shows Committee accepts no responsibility for the safety of plants or other personal property. All reasonable precautions against theft and damage will be taken, but all exhibits will be staged at their owner's risk.
17. Entry to the show hall will be by an advance ticket, details to be advertised.
18. Entry in the show constitutes acceptance of the rules.
